350 participants

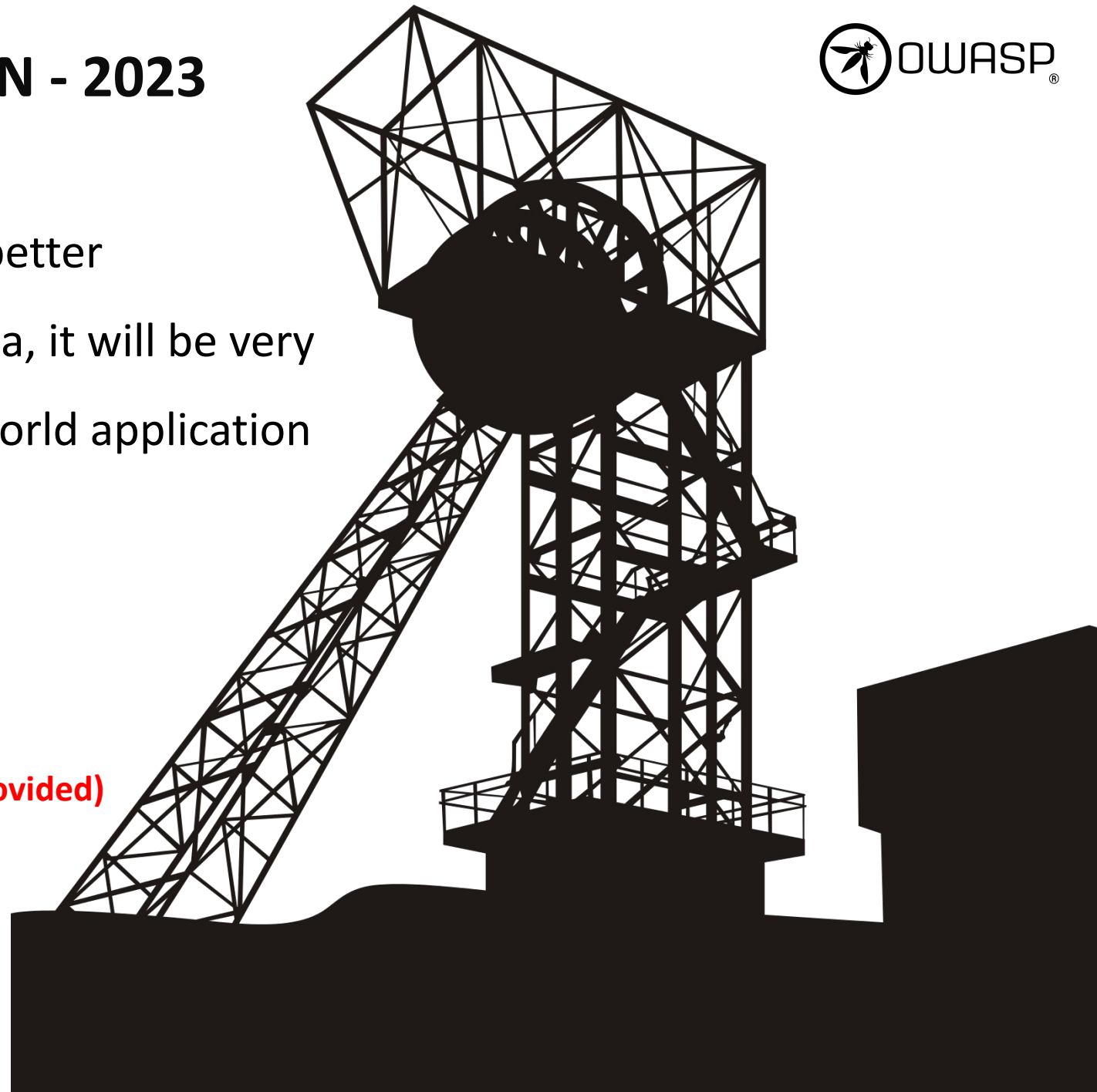


UNDERGROUND EDITION - 2023


